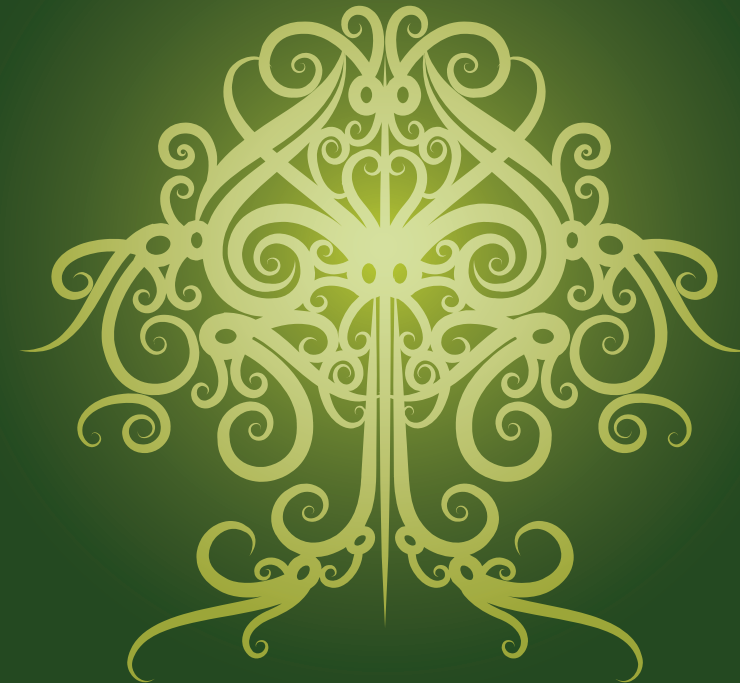

Nurturing The Tree of Life ('Puûn Udip')

The symbol above is inspired by a Dayak tribal ornament depicting Puûn Udip (the Tree of Life). The Dayak people have traditionally been the guardians of the forests, protecting them as a common heritage for the benefit of future generations. All cultural expression and arts - including community myth and knowledge as well as spiritual values - are focused on the forests, which symbolise the harmony of biosphere and humankind. This crucial interdependence is reflected in the intricate interwoven and unbroken lines of the design. Like so many leaves on the Tree of Life every one and every thing is interconnected in fragile equilibrium.
